Description: We shall visit The Cinema Museum in Kennington, a charitable organisation founded in 1986 by Ronald Grant and Martin Humphries from their own extensive private collections of items and memorabilia relating to cinema. Two tours guided by the founders will be given covering both the history of cinema as popular art and aspects of the technology.

The Museum is situated in the Master's House, the administrative centre of the former Lambeth Workhouse which Charlie Chaplin entered as a child when his mother faced destitution.

We shall take a pub lunch at The Dog House nearby where tables will be reserved for us in their upstairs dining room.

Where and when to meet: We assemble at the Museum's Café for refreshments at a 10:30 with a view to starting the first tour at 11:00.



Getting there: To the Cinema Museum: The Cinema Museum is located in Kennington, close to the Elephant and Castle. Address: *The Master's House, 2 Dugard Way (off Renfrew Road), London SE11* 4TH (see map). The nearest tube/train stations are Kennington (Northern Line) and Elephant and Castle (Northern and Bakerloo lines, and BR). Both are within easy walking distance. To the Dog House: Members walk together from the Museum to this nearby pub for lunch. The Dog House is at 293 Kennington Road, London SE11 6BY. Return on foot for the afternoon tour.
